

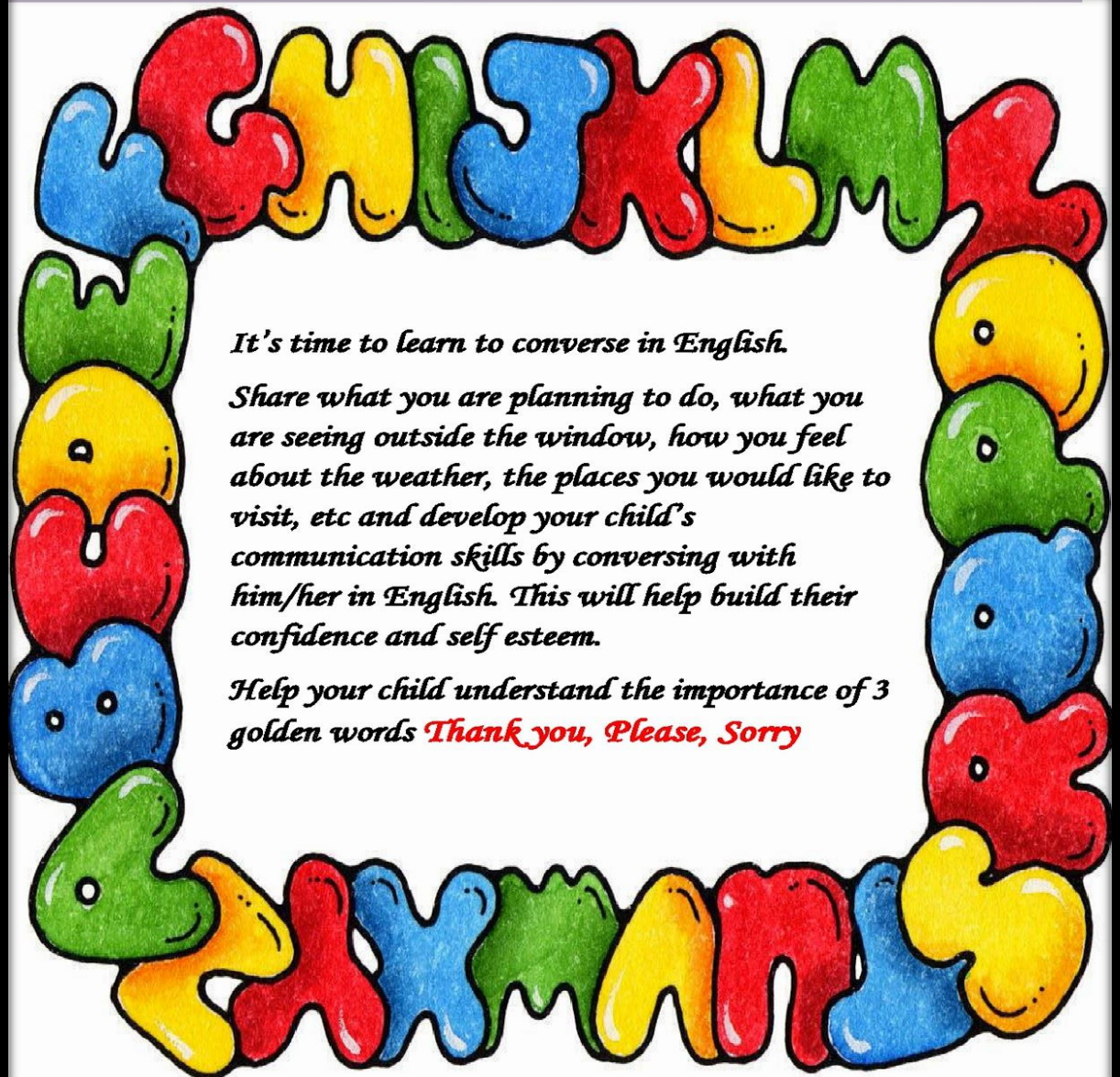

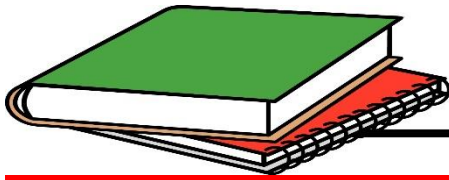
Summer Activities FOR KIDS

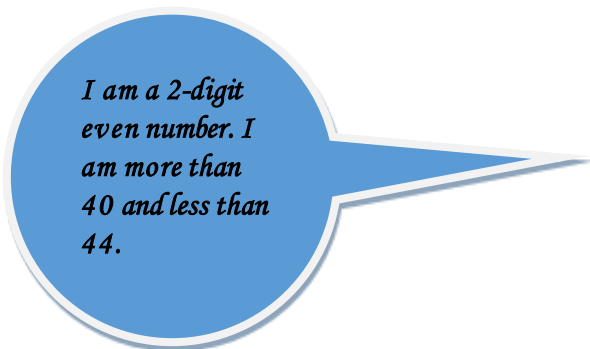
I am an odd number. I am more than 140 but less than 142.

I am the smallest 3-digit number. If you add 4, my digits become



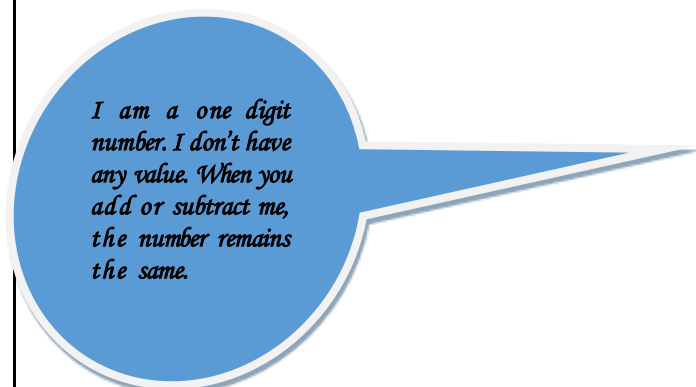
I am not an even number. I am between 160 and 164. I am not 163.



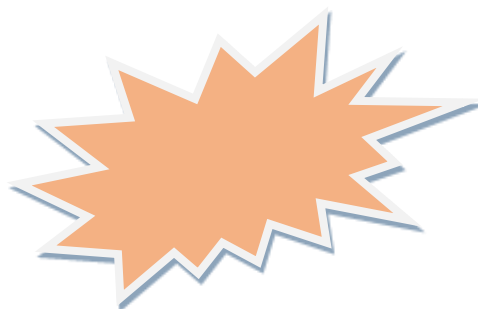
I am a 2-digit even number. I am more than 40 and less than 44.



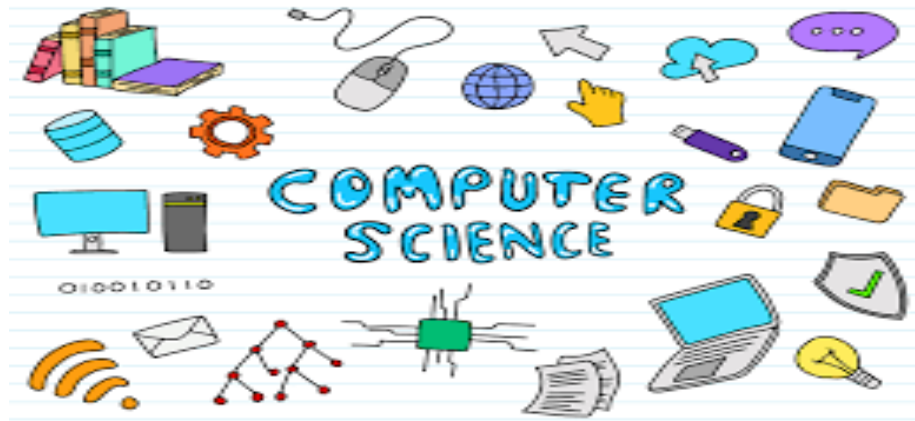
