Day 1 - Facilitator Mr. S Natarajan (Vice Principal Academics)

Natarajan apprised the educators that the New Education Policy is based on the pillars of “access, equity, quality, affordability, accountability” and it will radically transform India into a “vibrant knowledge hub”. He familiarised teachers with the creation of a new structure in place of the old, i.e., replacing 10+2 with 5+3+3+4. He also discussed the redesigned report cards which will be a “holistic, 360-degree, multidimensional report that would reflect in great detail the progress, skills and uniqueness of each learner in the cognitive, affective and psychomotor domains. He also added that the progress report will include self-assessment, peer assessment and teacher assessment.

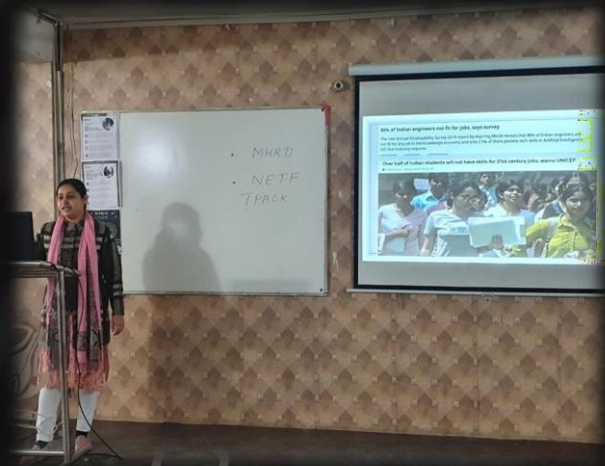

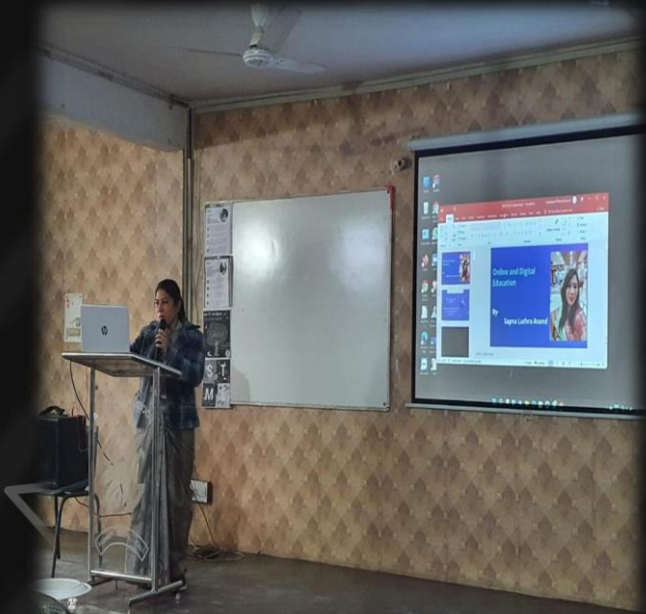
She added that multidisciplinary education will focus on the integrated development of individual including - social, physiological, emotional, social and moral.

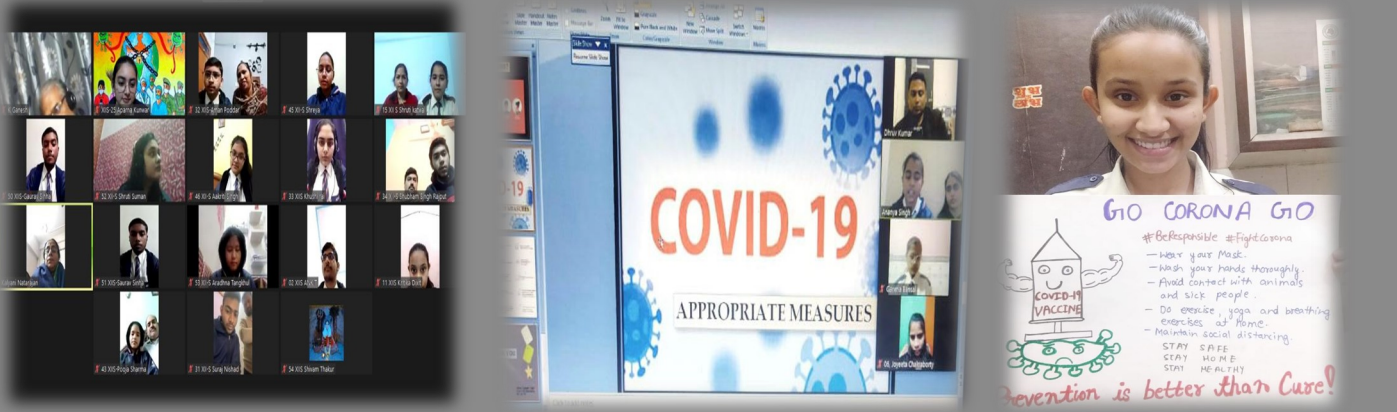
Day 6- Ms. Sapna Anand (PGT Computer Science)

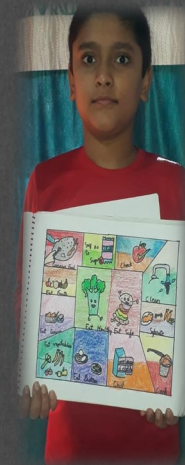
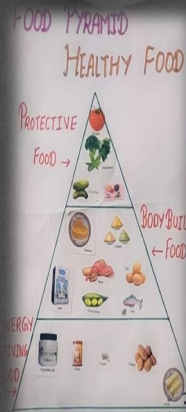
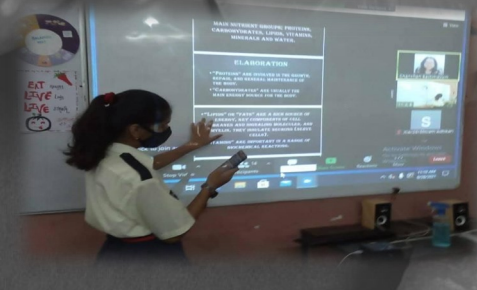

RASHTRIYA POSHAN MAAH



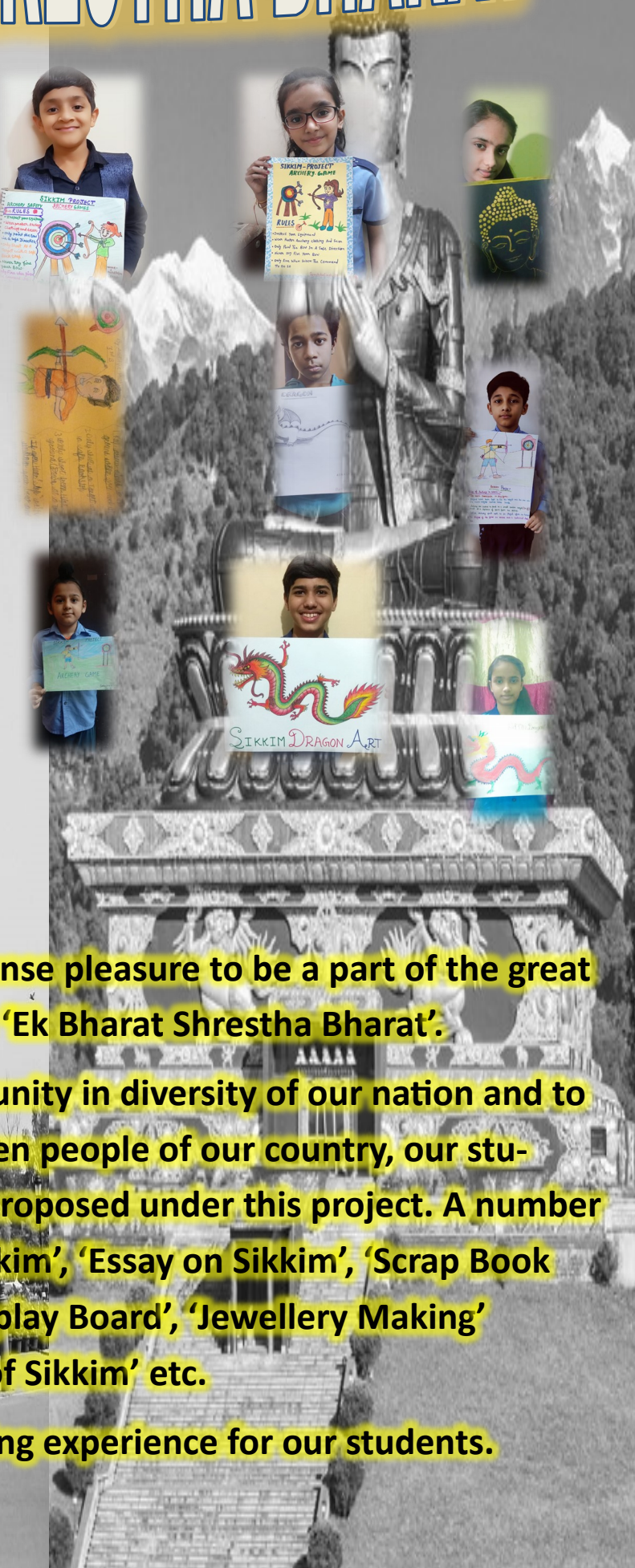

The exhibition attracted the virtual visitors in the subject-wise exhibit rooms.

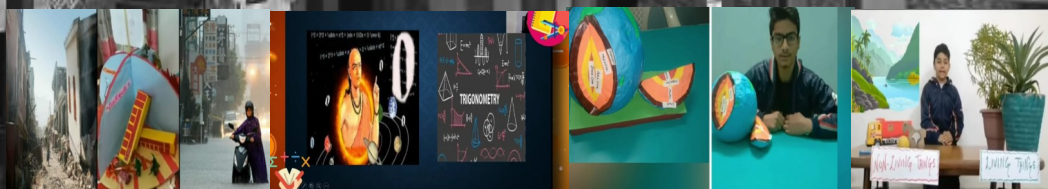

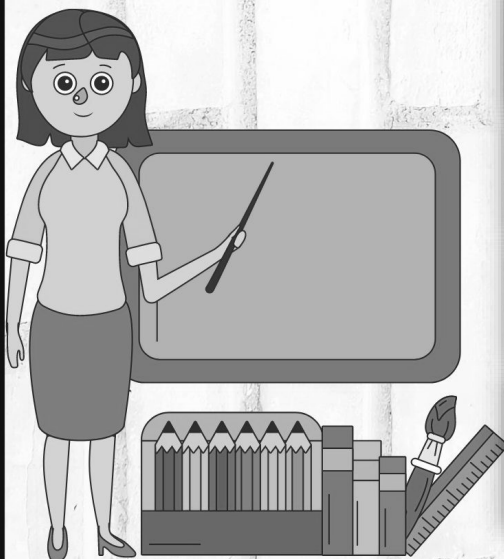
TEACHER'S DAY

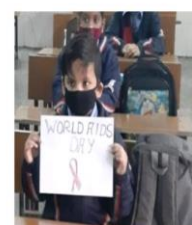
During the first week of Advent, students of class V visited the Bethany Convent, Burari run by the

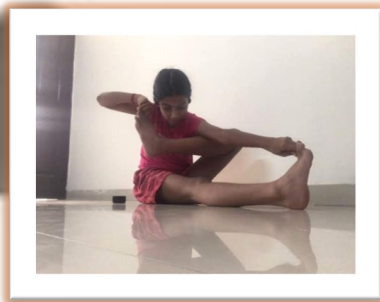
CBSE Fit India Freedom Run 2.0

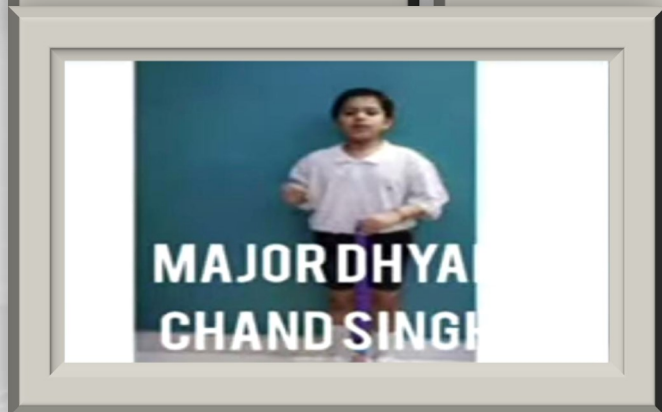
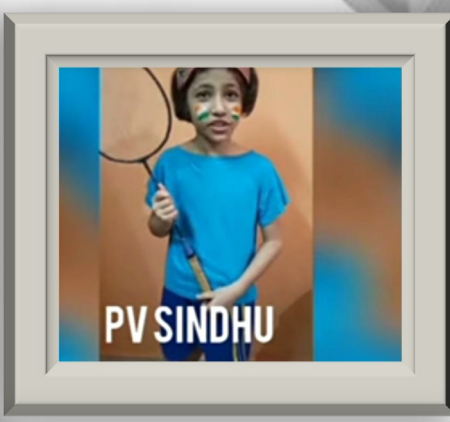
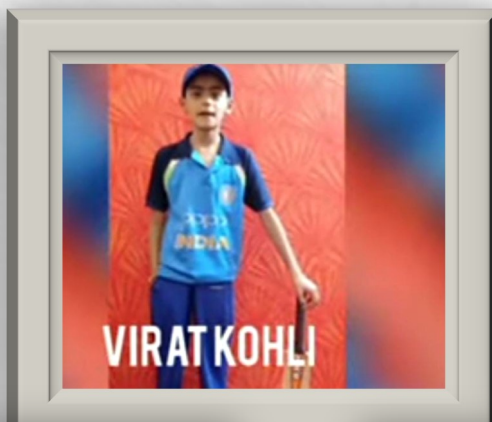
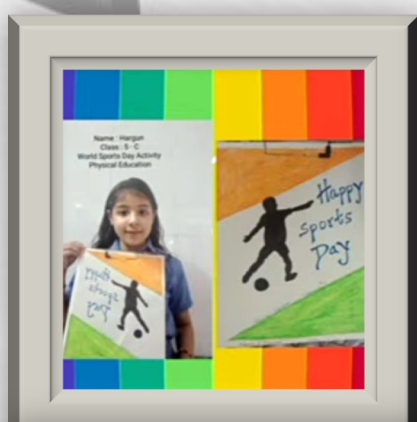
Yoga Day Celebration 2021- Class I to V

IN CONVERSATION WITH ASG Mr. VINEET DHANDA



Most people have a role model who inspires them to achieve certain goals or lifestyles. In our pursuit to elevate ourselves to high echelons in life, we often seek our lode star in a person who has reached a high pinnacle in life through sheer hard work and adroitness. We were privileged to have a candid talk virtually on ZOOM with an eminent Advocate, Mr. Vineet Dhanda, an honoured alumnus of Apex Public School, an inspiration for our young achievers.

Mr. Vineet Dhanda is a renowned and prominent counsel at the Honourable Supreme Court of India. He has been associated with the International Bar Council for several years and has represented the Central and State governments of India in courts. He is a recipient of the prestigious 'Delhi Gaurav Puruskar' and was felicitated at Society Achiever's Awards, 2018 for Legal Fraternity of India. Mr. Vineet Dhanda is recently appointed as an Assistant Solicitor General of India at Supreme Court of India for the High Court of Rajasthan, Jaipur Bench. Besides representing the government, he spared time to extend his legal acumen in his philanthropic representation of underprivileged, towards protection of the Fundamental Rights enshrined in the Constitution of the Republic of India.

In the fleeting moments of time, we sat enraptured listening to anecdotes and insights from our esteemed guest, from his experiences in academia to his hobbies, favourite food and books.

Aparna: Sir, we students rely increasingly on internet to solve our day-to-day problems. How was your childhood during the non-digital period?

It is my honour to meet you all. I'm happy to meet my teachers. My childhood, since class 5 when I came to Apex, was spent in school as we had day boarding school, which got dismissed at 5 pm and we would reach home at 7 pm. The digital life did not touch us as our day was spent in study at school and commuting and completing lots of homework. Today's generation is a little blessed because media is also a menace. My boys are aged 15 and 14 years, and whenever I want to talk to them, it's in monosyllables as they are busy in the digital world. I did watch movies and hung out with friends occasionally, my childhood was typically a simple middle class life.



Shreya: Please share with us your happy memories in Apex Public School.

There are many happy memories of Apex School. I joined Apex in class 5 and the first person I met in school was **Mr. A. M. Jonathan**. I owe my success to few people who have inspired me. One of them is Mrs.

Kalyani Natarajan, my teacher. I had got compartmental in my 12 standard, and it was Kalyani ma'am who had told my father that I would be an achiever in life. I credit Mr. A.M Jonathan to my English language skills which has stood me well in legal drafting and arguments in courts. Mr. A.M Jonathan was a disciplinarian; we were not allowed to speak in Hindi. I owe my success to Apex Public School, 95% to my teachers and principal sir. I do still visit his grave whenever I get time, especially on his birthday, on 25 January and his death anniversary. I have good memories of Apex and friends and teachers. Sunita ma'am was our crush. We cherished our teachers, it was a fun time, very precious time.

Khushi: You stand as an inspiration today. Who did you look up to during your formative years and who is your role model today?

This is a very tricky question. I would say that I watched a lot of law movies and still do. Though I did not have any role model, but I did idolise two people in my life. One of them is Shri Kiren Rijiju ji, the Law minister of India. He is a good friend, and his dexterity is an inspiration. During his stint as a sports minister of India, he went to attend winter sports in - 35 degrees in Leh/Laddhak. Such persons have been my inspiration. However, in legal field none has stood as my role model. As a role model, I can point out a law movie of Al Pacino - 'And Justice for All'. It has taught me the role and responsibilities as a lawyer. I have represented against terrorists and for gangsters, and none has stood as an inspiration. I reiterate that I look up to hard-working persons like Shri Kiren Rijiju ji, who is my inspiration. I must confess that I am not a hard-working person, but I am a smart working person. I try to find solutions smartly in a quicker way. It's my privilege to meet you all. It is a nostalgic moment for me.

Pooja: You are a successful person in the legal field. Please share with us your success mantra.



Success mantra is 'Hard-work'. Though I am contradicting myself, what I mean is that I am meticulous in my work. During my 9 years practice in Mumbai, I have represented many Film Stars. They taught me one thing i.e., time is money. The other thing is to pray. What I cannot talk with anyone, I talk with God. In short, hard work is the key to success. After 12 standard, career specialization should be chosen carefully. Whatever you may chose, you must give your best to it. I was an average student, but since I have taken up legal profession, each brief I take up is meticulously handled.

One must do his best to be the best in what he does. However, one must keep fit and physically active in life for a successful life. So, in my book of success mantra, I prioritize 1. Fitness; 2. Mental Fitness; 3. Hard work; and 4. God.

Aparna: Sir, I am a science student. Is the transition from science stream to legal stream advisable? How did you cope up with the change?

Any person with science background will do well in law. I am a criminal lawyer by profession and have found my biology acumen handy for my profession. I have also undergone a ballistic study to supplement my knowledge. Changing from science was not difficult. A good common sense is essential to being a good lawyer.

Aman Poddar: Nowadays, 'Me Time' is a must in every person's daily routine to refresh their mind and soul. How do you spend your 'Me Time'?

My 'Me Time' is with my Boys - my family. I charge less, when I take my family along with me when on a tour for work. Another 'Me Time' is listening to good music. I love to hear songs and playing video games with my boys. We as a family play Ludo before bed. "Me Time" is very essential in life today.

Shradha: Career challenges perhaps were very different from what we face today. Share with us the challenges you faced in the initial phase of your career.

I passed my law in 2003. I started my career as an independent criminal lawyer at Tis Hazari Courts. My first case was before the Constitution Bench of Supreme Court of India. I was extremely nervous and shaky but stood my ground with meticulous work. I have appeared

before Justice S. Ravindra who used to ask questions from the briefs,

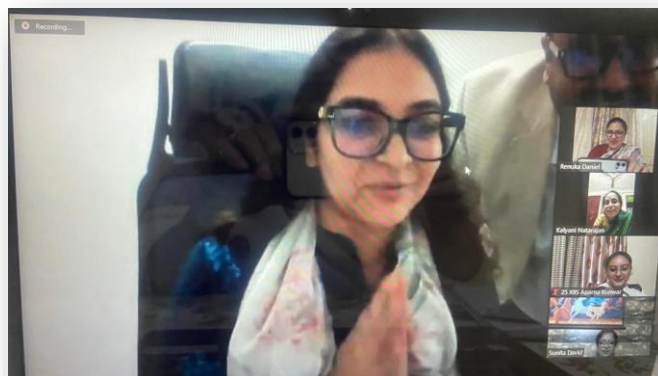
which prompted me to always be prepared. At the start, I visited many 'Thanas' for cases. I used to meet film Stars introduced by Mr. Pahlaj Nihalani and the first case was defending allegations of plagiarism. I have filed Public Interest Litigations which has prompted governments to frame laws. It has been a good journey and I could not have contemplated another profession. Since past two years I have been representing the government and am enjoying my work.

Shraddha: Justice delayed, is justice denied. Based on this maxim, what is your view on dispensation of justice and pendency of cases in India?

Problem of pendency of litigation is frivolous in cases. The law department is taking measures to deal with pending litigations. Judges are being appointed and measures are being taken to dispose of old cases. Digitization is being taken up seriously and things will be cleared soon within few years.

Nandani: You have been engaged as an ASG for Jaipur Bench, High Court of Rajasthan. Kindly tell us about your role as an ASG.

Those High Courts that have lesser burden, appoint the in-charge of Court as an Assistant Solicitor General. Any case against Union of India, I must handle, giving legal advice to different government departments. My forte is film industry handling four production houses. As an ASG I have just started.



Aastha Chettri: If you were to start your career all over again, would you still pursue a legal career and if yes, would you do anything differently?

I will not choose things differently and pursue the same career. I will try to be more independent and work hard.

Shraddha: Sir, what is your final message to students who wish to pursue a legal career?

Anybody who wishes to pursue any career, must be focussed and clear on the career path. When you choose a profession, it should have good money. Put your soul to it and pray.

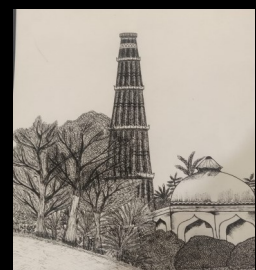
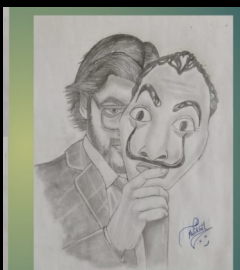
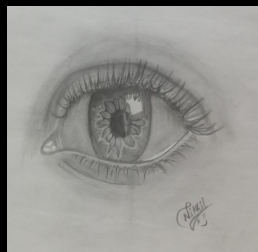
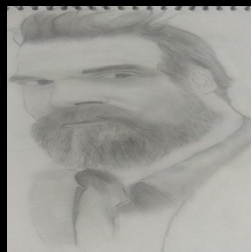
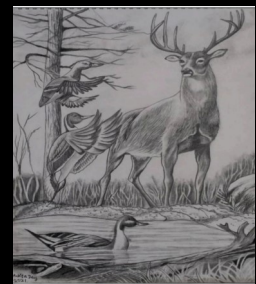
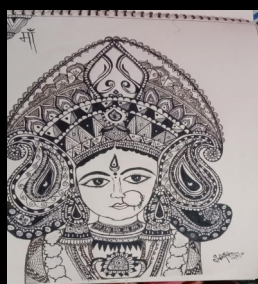
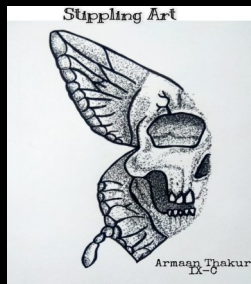
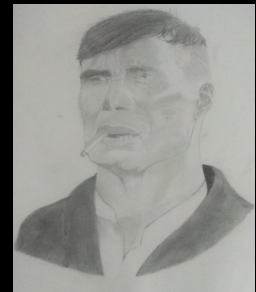
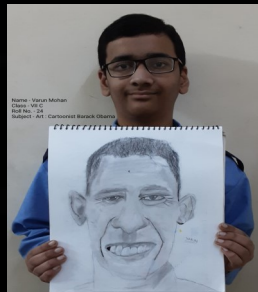
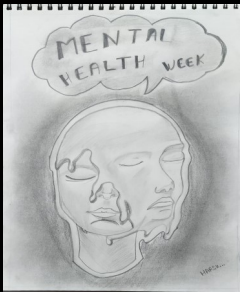

विज्ञान और तकनीक



विज्ञान और तकनीक लोगों के जीवन का एक बहुत ही महत्वपूर्ण हिस्सा है, यह सिंधु घाटी सभ्यता से ही हमारे जीवन का एक महत्वपूर्ण हिस्सा रहा है। ऐसा पाया गया है कि, आग और पहिये की खोज करने के लिए लगभग पाँच आविष्कार किए गए थे। दोनों ही आविष्कारों को वर्तमान समय के सभी तकनीकी आविष्कारों का जनक कहा जाता है। आग के आविष्कार के माध्यम से लोगों ने ऊर्जा की शक्ति के बारे में पहली बार जाना था। तभी से, लोगों में रुचि बढ़ी और उन्होंने जीवन-शैली को सरल और आसान बनाने के लिए बहुत से साधनों पर शोध के और अधिक कठिन प्रयास करने शुरू कर दिए।

तकनीक में उन्नति के कुछ उदाहरण, रेलवे प्रणाली की स्थापना, मेट्रो की स्थापना, रेलवे आरक्षण प्रणाली, इंटरनेट, सुपर कम्प्यूटर, मोबाइल, स्मार्ट फोन, लगभग सभी क्षेत्रों में लोगों की ऑनलाइन पहुँच, आदि है। भारत की सरकार बेहतर तकनीकी विकास के साथ ही देश में विकास के लिए अंतरिक्ष संगठन, और कई शैक्षणिक संस्थाओं (विज्ञान में उन्नति के लिए भारतीय संगठन) में अधिक अवसरों का निर्माण कर रही है।

भारत के कुछ प्रसिद्ध वैज्ञानिक जिन्होंने भारत में (विभिन्न क्षेत्रों में अपने उल्लेखनीय वैज्ञानिक शोध के माध्यम से) तकनीकी उन्नति को संभव बना दिया, उनमें से कुछ सर जे.सी.बोस, एस.एन.बोस, सी.वी.रमन, डॉ. होमी जे.भाभा, श्रीनिवास रामानुजन, परमाणु ऊर्जा के जनक डॉ. हर गोबिंद सिंह खुराना, विक्रम साराभाई आदि हैं।

विज्ञान और तकनीक के क्षेत्र में विकास किसी भी देश के लोगों के लिए दूसरे देश के लोगों के साथ कंधे से कंधा मिलाकर चलने के लिए बहुत अधिक आवश्यक है। विज्ञान और तकनीक का विकास तथ्यों के विश्लेषण और उचित समझ पर निर्भर करता है। प्रौद्योगिकी का विकास सही दिशा में विभिन्न वैज्ञानिक ज्ञान के आवेदन के तरीकों पर निर्भर करता है।

विज्ञान और प्रौद्योगिकी आधुनिकरण के हर पहलू को प्रत्येक राष्ट्र में लागू किया गया है। जीवन के हर एक क्षेत्र को सही ढंग से संचालित करने और लगभग सभी समस्याओं को सुलझाने के लिए आधुनिक उपकरणों की खोज की गई है। इसे चिकित्सा, शिक्षा, बुनियादी ढांचा, ऊर्जा निर्माण, सूचना प्रौद्योगिकी और अन्य क्षेत्रों में लागू किए बिना सभी लाभों को प्राप्त करना संभव है।
