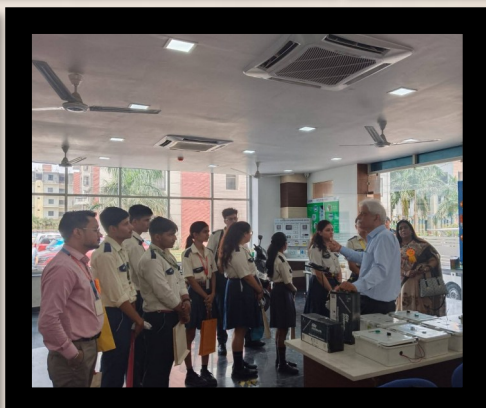
## Empowering Educators: Apex Public School's Capacity Building Initiative

Apex Public School's Inter-House Chess and Table Tennis Competition (July 16, 2025) results:

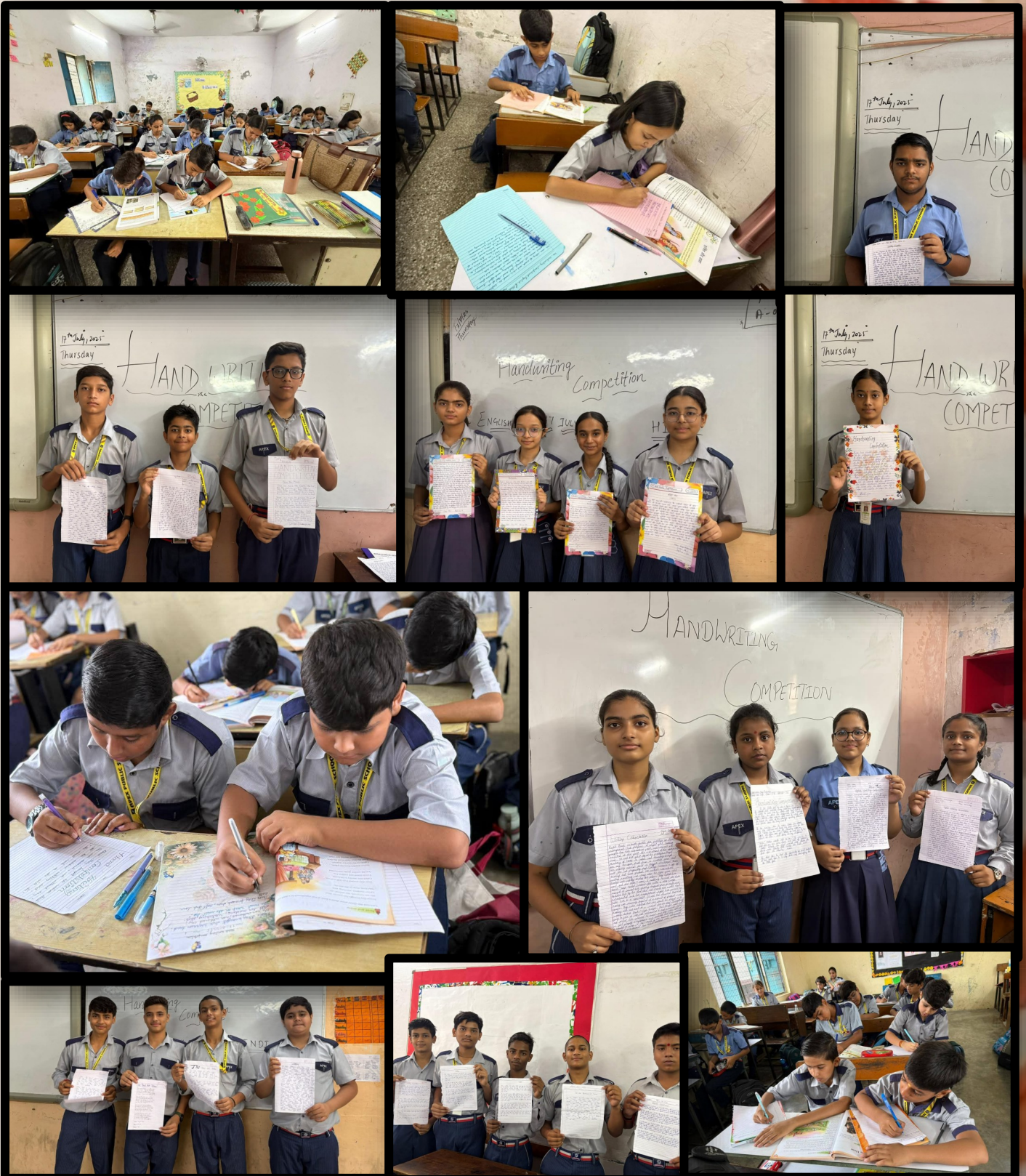

# Kindness in Action: "Wall of Kindness" Donation Drive Success

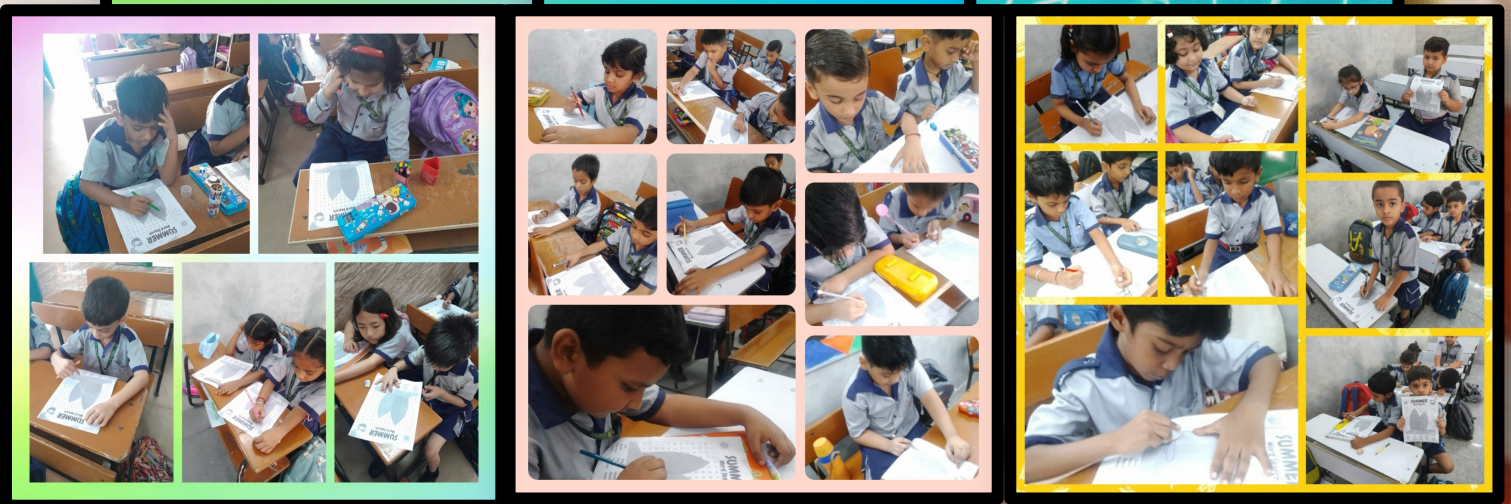

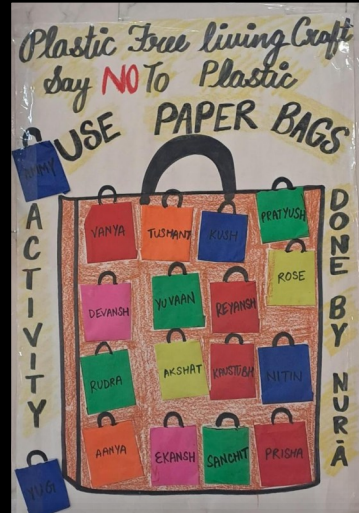
## Welcome Back, Class 1! Summer Holidays Bingo Fun!
